

# Strathpine station accessibility upgrade

## Night and weekend works – scheduled track closure

### Saturday 16 and Sunday 17 February 2019

As part of the Strathpine station accessibility upgrade, continuous works will be undertaken at the station on **Saturday 16 and Sunday 17 February 2019**.

These works are being undertaken during a scheduled track closure, when the station is closed and rail replacement buses will operate.

Residents near the station may experience some noise associated with construction activity and truck movements. Mobile lighting towers will be used, as required, during night works.

Works include the removal of redundant overhead masts and drilling (bored piling) deep into the ground and backfilling with steel and concrete to form the foundation for the new footbridge, lift shafts and platforms. The disturbed platform surface will be reinstated to ensure the platform is ready for customers on Monday morning.

An accessible pedestrian path between Nicol Way and South Pine Road will be maintained at all times and the temporary stair-only footbridge will be open.
