



Nambour station accessibility upgrade

Night works – Thursday 31 March and Friday 1 April 2016

As part of preparatory works for the Nambour station accessibility upgrade, bus layover works at the station will occur overnight on **Thursday 31 March between the hours of 11pm and 5am**. If required, additional overnight works will occur on Friday 1 April 2016, 11pm to 5am.

Queensland Rail is undertaking stormwater drainage work on Civic Way. This work is required to occur before the accessibility upgrade of the station can commence.

As part of this work, a lane closure and traffic management controls will be in place on Civic Way.

Residents and businesses adjacent to Nambour station may experience some noise from truck movements and construction activity. Mobile lighting towers will be used during night works.
