Night works – footbridge stair installation

Saturday 17 April 2021

As part of the Cannon Hill station accessibility upgrade, Queensland Rail will install new footbridge stairs overnight on **Saturday 17 April 2021** (weather and construction conditions permitting).

For safety, these works have been scheduled when there is no rail traffic and the overhead power is switched off.

Residents near the station may experience some noise associated with construction activity and the operation of cranes, trucks and equipment around the work zone.

Every effort will be made to minimise disruption and we thank you for your patience while we build you a better Cannon Hill station.
