WORKS NOTICE

Footpath closed for construction works – Aberdeen Parade, Boondall

From Tuesday 29 January 2019

As part of the Boondall station accessibility upgrade, the footpath on the eastern (station) side of Aberdeen Parade will be closed from Tuesday 29 January 2019 for the duration of construction works.

Throughout construction, **detour signage will be in place to direct pedestrians and road users safely around the work zone.**

Motorists are requested to follow all instructions of the traffic controllers and drive to the changed traffic conditions. **Local access to private property will be maintained at all times.**

Some informal (unmarked) street parking on the station side of Aberdeen Parade will be affected by the establishment of the work zone. Station parking is provided adjacent to the Brisbane Entertainment Centre (access via Bicentennial Road and Melaleuca Drive).

Some vegetation clearing in the gardens adjacent to the station will be undertaken to enable construction.

Every effort will be made to carry out these works with minimal disruption.

We apologise for any inconvenience and thank you for your patience as we work to improve your station.

The Boondall station accessibility upgrade is part of Queensland Rail's \$300 million program to upgrade stations across the South East Queensland network, making them accessible for all customers.

Upgrade works are expected to be completed by mid-2020, weather and construction conditions permitting.
