WORKS NOTICE

Night and weekend works – footbridge removal

September 2018

As part of the Strathpine station accessibility upgrade, the station's original footbridge will be removed using a large crane over two nights on **Sunday 23 and Monday 24 September** (weather and construction conditions permitting), between **7pm and 4am** the next day.

For the safety of customers and project workers, these works must be carried out after hours when there is no rail traffic, power to the overhead lines is switched off and the carpark closed to the public. Nearby residents may experience some noise from crane operation, truck movements and construction activities. Portable lighting towers will also be in use at night.

Associated preparatory activities will be undertaken on **Saturday 22 September** (day works only).

While the station will open as normal over the weekend, the **western carpark will be closed** for public safety. The temporary stair-only footbridge may be open at times whenever the crane is not operating. **Customers and members of the public seeking to cross the rail corridor are encouraged to make alternative arrangements during this time.** The eastern carpark (Gympie Road side) will remain open with some changes.
