WORKS NOTICE

Night and weekend works – temporary footbridge installation

August 2018

As part of the Strathpine station accessibility upgrade, installation of the temporary footbridge and associated works will be undertaken on **Saturday 18 August** (day works only) and again over four nights from **Sunday 19 to Wednesday 22 August**, between **10.30pm and 4am** the next day.

Due to the nature of these activities and for the safety of customers and project workers, these works must be carried out outside of peak services or after hours when there is no rail traffic and power to the overhead lines is switched off. Nearby residents may experience some noise from the use of cranes, truck movements and construction activity at night. Portable lighting towers will also be in use.

Night works will not affect the first service each day. Activities on Monday 20 and Tuesday 21 August are platform-based works and services will operate as usual.

Every effort will be made to carry out these works with minimal disruption. Queensland Rail apologises for any inconvenience and appreciates your cooperation during these important works.
