Night works – temporary platform construction

Thursday 14 June 2018

As part of the Strathpine station accessibility upgrade, temporary platform works will be undertaken overnight on **Thursday 14 June 2018**, between the hours of **10.30pm and 4am** the next day. Works will not affect the first service on Friday.

Due to the nature of these activities and for the safety of customers and project workers, these works must be carried out after hours when there is reduced activity on the line.

Nearby residents may experience some noise from the use of cranes, truck movements and construction activity at night.
