WORKS NOTICE

Night works – assessment of overhead equipment

Sunday 17 and Monday 18 March 2019

Queensland Rail will undertake preliminary works on **Sunday 17 and Monday 18 March 2019 (8pm to 4am each night)**, in preparation for the Dakabin station accessibility upgrade.

These works involve the assessment of overhead equipment (recording measurements of heights and locations) to enable station upgrade works later in the year.

For the safety of workers and to maintain rail services, these works can only be undertaken at night when there are no services operating and the overhead power is switched off.

Crews with on-track vehicles will access the rail corridor at the level crossing at Mackie Road, Narangba.

Every effort will be made to minimise disruption and we apologise for any inconvenience as we work to improve your station.

Main construction for the station accessibility upgrade is expected to commence in late 2019.

The Dakabin station accessibility upgrade is part of Queensland Rail's \$300 million program to upgrade stations across the South East Queensland network, making them accessible for all customers.
