Night works – removal of overhead infrastructure

Tuesday 27 to Thursday 29 November 2018

As part of the Morayfield station accessibility upgrade, overhead mast removal works will be carried out over three nights from **Tuesday 27 to Thursday 29 November**, each night between **10pm and 4am the next morning** (weather and construction conditions permitting).

Due to the nature of these works and for the safety of customers and project workers, these works can only be undertaken at night when the power is switched off and there is no rail traffic on the line.

Works will not affect the first rail service each day.

Every effort will be made to carry out these works with minimal disruption.

We apologise for any inconvenience and thank you for your patience as we work to improve your station.
