Night works – temporary platform construction

May 2018

As part of preparatory works for the Strathpine station accessibility upgrade, temporary platform works will be undertaken on **selected nights in May 2018**, between the hours of **6pm and 4am** the next morning. Works will not affect the first service each day.

Due to the nature of these activities and for the safety of customers and project workers, these works must be carried out after hours when there is reduced activity on the line.

Nearby residents may experience some noise from truck movements and construction activity at night.
