In preparation for commencing operations of the new East Ipswich station building and infrastructure, Queensland Rail will undertake station commissioning works overnight on **Monday 29 November 2021, 8pm until 5am** the next day (weather and construction conditions permitting).

Activities include testing and commissioning the electrical and signalling systems and involve the use of hand tools and vehicle movements around the station precinct.

Due to the nature of these activities, works can only be undertaken out of hours when rail traffic is reduced.

Every effort will be made to minimise disturbance wherever possible. We apologise for any inconvenience and appreciate your patience as we undertake these important works.
