Night works – platform foundations

Wednesday 7 and Thursday 8 October 2020

As part of the East Ipswich station accessibility upgrade, Queensland Rail will undertake foundation screw piling (drilling) works **from 6pm to 6am** the next day over two nights, on **Wednesday 7 and Thursday 8 October 2020** (weather and construction conditions permitting).

These works can only be undertaken when there is reduced rail traffic and the overhead power is switched off. **Screw piling has been chosen specifically for this location to minimise noise and dust.**

While nearby residents may still notice some noise associated with construction activities in the vicinity of the work zone, every effort will be made to minimise disruption and we apologise for any inconvenience as we undertake these important works.
