Coomera to Helensvale Duplication

Night works – electrification and power systems

July-September 2017

As part of the Coomera to Helensvale Duplication, Queensland Rail is installing overhead electrification lines and rail power systems, between Coomera and Helensvale stations, on **selected nights from late July until early September**, weather and operational factors permitting.

The work requires the use of heavy machinery including trucks, cranes and lifts to run overhead electrical wire between mast foundations and conduct overhead modifications. For safety and in order to maintain train services during the day, these works must be undertaken at night.
