



Coomera to Helensvale Duplication Night works – overhead electrification systems

June 2017

As part of the Coomera to Helensvale Duplication, Queensland Rail is installing overhead electrification lines along the rail corridor between Coomera and Helensvale stations.

Installation of overhead electrification lines is scheduled to occur on selected nights in June, weather and operational factors permitting.

The work requires the use of heavy machinery including trucks, cranes and lifts to run overhead electrical wire between mast foundations and conduct overhead modifications. These works must be undertaken at night for safety reasons and in order to maintain train services during the day.

Residents located near the rail corridor in these areas may experience increased noise and may also be impacted by the use of lighting associated with this activity. Every effort will be made to carry out these works with minimal disruption.
