As part of the Morayfield station accessibility upgrade, communications provider TPG will undertake essential works to relocate fibre-optic cabling within the station precinct **between 6am and 6pm on Sunday 14 October** (weather and construction conditions permitting).

The date of these works has been determined by the provider and cannot be rescheduled as the infrastructure serves other stakeholders on the state's fibre-optic network.

Every effort will be made to carry out these works with minimal disruption. We apologise for any inconvenience and appreciate your cooperation during these essential works.

Train services will not be affected.
