

# Timber bridge replacements

## Grandchester – November 2018

Queensland Rail is replacing 18 rail bridges between Ipswich and Chinchilla with more durable steel structures to improve the safety and reliability of our network.

Works will now be undertaken during November to prepare two bridges near Grandchester, indicated below and on the map overleaf, for replacement in early 2019.

### Overview of work

Two bridges between Grandchester and 2.5km east of Grandchester  (Refer to map on reverse)	<b>Mid-November to early December 2018</b> (weather and construction conditions permitting)  6.30am to 6.30pm (Monday to Saturday)  Continuous works to replace bridges during a planned track closure in early 2019.	Site establishment, piling and preparation works ahead of bridge replacement.  <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Heavy machinery including piling rig, crane and trucks with reversing beepers and flashing lights</li><li>• Access to these bridges has been shown on the map overleaf.</li></ul>
