



SEQ Rail Stabling Program

Boondall night works

As part of the SEQ Rail Stabling Program, Queensland Rail and CPB Contractors will be undertaking track isolation activities north of Boondall station from **Sunday 5 to Wednesday 8 November 2017** and south of Nudgee station from **Tuesday 7 to Wednesday 8 November 2017**.

Works will involve the use of mobile cranes for the removal and installation of trackside electrical equipment. Temporary generator lighting will be used to provide a safe working environment.

These activities will occur outside normal working hours, as outlined below:

You will notice the following around your local area and on-site during these works:

- Delivery and unloading of materials and use of machinery such as elevated work platform, mobile cranes, and generators
- Use of small power tools such as drills, saws and minor vibrating equipment
- Use of on-track vehicles, elevated work platform, mobile cranes and light towers
- Vehicle routes and works on the rail line adjacent to Aberdeen Parade, Boondall.
