SEQ Rail Stabling Program - Banyo Construction update

Throughout January and early-February, Queensland Rail and CPB Contractors (formerly known as Leighton Contractors) will continue vital construction activities as part of the SEQ Rail Stabling Program.

From Wednesday 20 January 2016 to Monday 25 January 2016, work is planned on the western side of the railway line from the northern end of the Banyo train station to adjacent to Jenson Street and on the eastern side of the station south of Eames Street.

Works will include identifying underground services and installing the foundations for overhead electrical line equipment masts.

To allow these works to occur, **access to the north western end of the Banyo station will be closed to pedestrians from 9.30am Friday 22 January to 7pm Sunday 24 January 2016.**

Pedestrians will be able to access Banyo station via Purchase Street and Tufnell Road. Traffic control will be in place to assist pedestrians. Changed traffic conditions, including reduced speed limits and short traffic delays, may be experienced on Purchase Street and Railway Parade.



If these works are not able to be completed during this time, the works and the pedestrian detour will continue as part of Queensland Rail's scheduled track closure of the Shorncliffe line from **2am Sunday 24 January 2016 to 4am Monday 25 January 2016.**



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During the Queensland Rail track closure, Queensland Rail and CPB Contractors will undertake vital construction activities along the rail corridor between the existing Shorncliffe railway line and the maintenance facilities adjacent to Royal Parade.

Work impacts will include:

- Use of machinery such as excavators, mobile cranes, front-end loaders, generators and track mountable excavators and resurfacing machines
- Delivery trucks and workers' vehicles entering the site via Guardhouse Road
- Mobile lighting towers to light the work areas
- Delivery and unloading of materials.

Vegetation removal

Minor vegetation removal is required on Queensland Rail property adjacent to the existing maintenance facility to allow for construction of a new access road, carpark and crew facilities. These works will start mid-January 2016 and are expected to be completed early-February 2016, weather permitting.

Vegetation removal will be undertaken in accordance with required environmental guidelines. A fauna spotter will be onsite to survey trees prior to clearing.

While the project is underway, you will notice some changes around your local area including:

- Increased truck and vehicle movements along Earnshaw Road and Guardhouse Road from Monday to Saturday 6.30am to 5pm
- Workers may arrive onsite between 5.30am and 6.30am to prepare for the day's activities
- Installation of security lighting onsite that will be screened from residential areas
- Establishment of storage and lay down areas for construction materials
- Delivery trucks and workers' vehicles entering the site via Guardhouse Road
- Use of machinery such as excavators, mobile cranes, front-end loaders, generators and track mountable excavators and resurfacing machines
- Delivery and unloading of materials.

Every effort will be made to keep disruption to a minimum. We appreciate your patience during the construction period and will continue to update you as work progresses.
