

Banyo pedestrian footbridge installation Night works

Monday 25 and Tuesday 26 September 2017

Queensland Rail is constructing a new pedestrian bridge at the northern end of Banyo station.

Due to construction issues, the pedestrian bridge was unable to be installed during the last track closure in July. The footbridge structure will now be lifted into place during the nights of Monday 25 and Tuesday 26 September.

Following this installation, minor site clean up and finishing works will be undertaken until approximately mid-October 2017.
