The new, modern station will help people in wheelchairs, parents with prams and those travelling with luggage or who are injured, to access to our trains with ease.


# Construction progress and station reopening

Inclement weather, including the impacts of Tropical Cyclone Alfred, excessive rainfall throughout February and March, as well as complex site constraints have continued to impact this major accessibility upgrade.

To ensure we deliver a completed station for our customers, we are aiming to reopen Banyo station mid-year.

Activities recently undertaken on-site include:

- continuing construction of station entrances and the ticket office
- continuing platform works and installation of platform shelters, including screening and roofing
- reinstatement of property boundary fences adjoining the station precinct
- continuing fit-out of footbridge and lift installation.





### **Upcoming works**

Customers and the community can expect to see the following activities at Banyo in the coming weeks:

- ongoing fit-out of ticket office
- commissioning of new platform lighting
- lift installation and commissioning activities
- landscaping throughout the station precinct
- construction of upgraded bicycle facilities
- finishing works throughout the station.

We will continue to keep you updated as works progress.

Works will generally take place between **6am and 6pm, Monday to Saturday,** unless notified. Prior notification will be provided for after hours activities (nights, Sundays or public holidays).
