



Banyo station accessibility upgrade

The Banyo station accessibility upgrade is part of the State Government's ongoing investment to upgrade stations to make them accessible for everyone.



Project benefits

Banyo station is being upgraded to make it more accessible, and easier for customers and the community to travel on our network. The new, modern station will help people in wheelchairs, parents with prams and those travelling with luggage or who are injured use the station with ease.

We look forward to reopening the station to customers, as soon as it is safe to do so, in the second-half of the year.



Construction progress

Major construction works have been progressing well on site. Recent activities at Banyo include::

- ✓ foundations (piling) platforms, footbridge and lift shafts (pictured, right and over)
- excavation works throughout the station precinct
- √ installation of underground services
- ✓ electrical and lighting upgrade associated Energex and civil works
- ✓ modification of existing footbridge staircases
- ✓ fabrication of new footbridge and staircases (in progress).











Upcoming works

In the coming months, you can expect to see the following activities on site:

- installation of lift shafts
- construction of new raised platforms and station building/ticket office
- construction of new station entrance plaza (St Vincent's Road)
- fabrication of new footbridge and staircases (ongoing, off-site)
- installation of new footbridge and staircases, involving large crane operation (planned for September).

Works will generally take place between 6am and 6pm Monday to Saturday, unless notified. Every effort will be made to carry out these works with respect for our neighbours and customers.



Alternative transport

Shuttle bus 316 continues to operate between Banyo and Northgate stations to keep customers moving during the station upgrade.
