Banyo station lighting



What?

Queensland Rail's contractor will undertake an around-the-clock lighting test ('burn-in') at Banyo station, as part of the accessibility upgrade.

This test is a necessary step in commissioning the station's new lighting design and involves operating the precinct's lighting at full brightness continuously for 72 hours.



When?

72-hour operation of station lighting on **Friday 16, Saturday 17 and Sunday 18 May 2025** (around-the-clock).



Where?

Banyo station precinct, including platforms.



Impacts



Station lighting operating continuously at full brightness



Around-the-clock lighting test (72 hours - Friday to Sunday)



Electrical works, personnel present throughout the precinct, use of machinery and powered tools



Movement of vehicles with flashing lights and reversing beepers
