Queensland Rail's contractor will install signage at the new St Vincent's Road entry plaza, adjacent to the footpath area, as part of the Banyo station accessibility upgrade.

Excavation will be carried out using a vacuum excavation truck, with intermittent noise anticipated.

For safety, traffic management will be in place to assist pedestrian access along the footpath and across the rail corridor via the level crossing or station lifts and footbridge.



When?

Works will be undertaken **Wednesday 6 to Friday 8 August 2025, each day between 9am and 2:30pm**.



Where?

Banyo station - St Vincent's Road entry plaza and adjacent footpath area.

Vacuum excavation truck and/or crane will be positioned in St Vincent's Road (shoulder closed) with traffic management for the safety of motorists and pedestrians.

Pedestrian access will be maintained for access across the rail corridor via the level crossing or station lifts and footbridge.
