Banyo station





What?

Queensland Rail will undertake after hours works during a weekend track closure, as part of the Banyo station accessibility upgrade.

Activities involve the operation of large cranes, positioned around the station, to lift in upgrade infrastructure and construction materials.



When?

Early morning activities **from 3am to 6.30am** (prior to regular day shifts) on:

• Thursday 18 and Friday 19 July.

Around-the-clock works from 5pm Friday 19 until 6.30am Monday 22 July.

Road closure and traffic diversion from 3am Saturday 20 until 4am Monday 22 July.



Where?

Four large cranes will be positioned adjacent to the station precinct, including in road reserve and private property (by prior arrangement with property owners).

A full road closure will be in operation at the corner of Royal Parade and Tufnell Road (between the level crossing and Purchase Street), with a traffic diversion via Elliott Road, Froude Street, Musgrave Road and Kennaway Street (see map over).

Access to private property will be maintained at the direction of traffic controllers.

Pedestrian access will be maintained via the footpath (shops/cafe side).

For safety, there may be short delays during crane lifts.



Impacts



Operation of large cranes, movement of trucks and vehicles with flashing lights and reversing beepers



Construction noise, truck movements, crane operation, machinery and powered tools



After hours works - nights and weekend



Full road closure with traffic diversion



Lighting towers at night
