

Weekend works

Banyo station



What?

Queensland Rail will undertake weekend works for the Banyo station accessibility upgrade during a scheduled weekend track closure.

Works include finishing works throughout the precinct including platform surface sealing and cleaning, roofing activities, electrical works and minor repairs.

Due to the nature of the works, the station precinct will be closed, with platforms, lifts, footbridges and carpark unavailable over the weekend.



When?

After hours works (weekend, day shifts only) **from 6am to 6pm on Saturday 21 and Sunday 22 June 2025.**



Where?

Banyo station precinct, including entrances, platforms, carpark and rail corridor.

There will be no cross-corridor access via the new lifts and footbridge (pedestrian detour in operation).

On-track vehicles will access the work zones via the St Vincent's Road level crossing, under traffic management. Short delays may be expected and motorists are requested to follow the instructions of the traffic controllers.



Impacts



Movement of trucks, elevated work platforms and on-track vehicles with flashing lights and reversing beepers



Construction noise, truck movements, operation of machinery and powered tools



Weekend works (day shifts only)



Station platforms, lifts, footbridges and carpark unavailable
