Bundamba station accessibility upgrade



PROJECT INTRODUCTION - JULY 2023

The Bundamba station accessibility upgrade is part of the State Government's ongoing investment to upgrade stations across the South East Queensland network, making them more accessible for customers.

About the project

The Bundamba station accessibility upgrade will deliver an improved station and facilities that provide a service that is accessible, easy to get to, and easy to use.

These improvements enable all customers to access the train, station and platforms via paths, ramps or lifts, without the need to use stairs.

Key features of the upgrade include:

- A new footbridge with lift access
- Improved accessible parking
- Full length high-level platforms
- Increased platform shelter
- Upgraded hearing augmentation loops and tactile ground surface indicators
- Upgraded security cameras and lighting
- New accessible parking and kiss 'n' ride
- New wayfinding and platform signage
- Upgraded station office and facilities.

Project status

Hutchinson Builders was recently appointed to deliver the Bundamba station upgrade with early works now commencing.

Hutchinson Builders has worked with Queensland Rail and recently delivered the South Bank platform 1 and East Ipswich station upgrades.

Early works to support this upgrade include overhead line infrastructure works, vegetation removal and ground screw pile testing.

Community consultation also helped inform the detailed design for this upgrade.

Upcoming works (see map)

Customers and the local community can expect to see the following activities in mid-2023:

- Ground screw pile testing and vacuum extraction for service investigation and installation preparation works
- Overhead line infrastructure works
- Signalling and construction works for 5 to 6
 August planned track closure (6am to 6pm)
- Site establishment works set up of the fenced material laydown area and site office on the upper Mining Street side
- Several **platform shelters** will be removed with some replaced by temporary shelters
- Both platforms will remain open with reduced widths and fencing in construction areas
- Temporary rear wall removal heritage shelter
- Removal and storage of artworks.

Works will generally take place 6am to 6pm Monday to Saturday, unless notified.
