Carpark and footbridge closure for site establishment works - From 10 November


Queensland Rail will carry out geotechnical, vegetation and site establishment works at Buranda station, for the upcoming station upgrade.

From **Friday 10 November** the Queensland Rail property at 13 Arne Street will be secured and unavailable for use, as this will become the contractor's site office for the duration of the upgrade. Site establishment works will take place here from **Saturday 11 November until mid-December**.

A temporary site office will also be installed at the Queensland Rail property at 36 Faversham Street and remain in place until **Friday 22 December**.

From **Friday 10 to Sunday 12 November** some vegetation will be removed and trimmed along the rail corridor, to enable upcoming upgrade works. The park 'n' ride and footbridge will be temporarily closed during this time to facilitate this work. Traffic management will be on site to assist vehicles.

Please assist by removing your vehicle from the property and carpark by **11pm on Thursday 9 November**. We appreciate your cooperation and patience while we work towards building you a better station.
