Burpengary station accessibility upgrade



PROJECT UPDATE – SEPTEMBER 2023

The Burpengary station accessibility upgrade is part of the State Government's ongoing investment to upgrade stations to make them accessible for everyone.

Project status

Works are progressing well with platform pier and piling works continuing. Platform shelters have been removed and replaced with temporary ones and the bus stop and kiss 'n' ride areas relocated.

Station closure (early January to late 2024)

To fast-track construction and deliver this upgrade as safely as possible, the station will close from January 2024. During this time, trains will run express through the station. Customers can look forward to the station reopening in the second half of 2024.

Queensland Rail recently asked the community to complete a survey to help us plan alternative transport during the closure to ensure customers can still get where they need to go.

Thank you to everyone who completed the alternative transport survey. We are currently collating your feedback and will update the community on the alternative transport plan for Burpengary station in the coming months.

Upcoming works

Customers and the local community can expect to see the following activities in late-2023:

- platform pier and piling works
- foundation and onsite construction works for the new overhead footbridge with lift access
- construction of new lift shafts (platform 1)
- infrastructure service works
- protection works to secure structures
- demolition works.

Works will generally take place 6am to 6pm Monday to Saturday, unless notified.

Impacts

During current upgrade works, you can expect:

- Carpark area layout changes (see map)
- Noise and machinery.

Every effort will be made to carry out these works with respect for our neighbours and customers.

About the project

Our new, modern station will help people in wheelchairs, parents with prams, and people with heavy luggage get easy access to our trains..

Key features include:

- a new footbridge with lift access
- improved seating and accessible parking
- full length, high-level platforms
- upgraded hearing augmentation loops and tactile ground surface indicators
- upgraded security cameras and lighting
- new wayfinding and platform signage
- new station office and facilities
- disability-compliant ticket windows.
