PROJECT UPDATE – FEBRUARY 2024

The Burpengary station accessibility upgrade is part of the State Government's ongoing investment to upgrade stations to make them accessible for everyone.

Station closure

Burpengary station is now closed and is expected to reopen in the second half of 2024.

Train services are running **express in both directions between Morayfield and Narangba**stations. **Trains are not stopping at Burpengary**.

Transport to and from Burpengary station

An accessible **shuttle bus service (Route 661)** is running between Burpengary and Narangba stations leaving from the Burpengary Road side.

Upcoming works

Customers and the local community can expect to see the following activities in early-2024:

- new lifts and footbridge construction
- **new station office** and facilities works
- platform raising works
- service and station infrastructure works.

The carpark on the Bantry Street side is closed with some parking available from the new driveway entrance from the city end of Burpengary Road.

With the old footbridge being removed, pedestrian access across the rail line will be via the Rowley Road level crossing.
