

Burpengary station accessibility upgrade



PROJECT UPDATE – JULY 2023

The Burpengary station accessibility upgrade is part of the State Government's ongoing investment to upgrade stations across the South East Queensland network, making them more accessible for customers.

Project status

Early works are well underway with ground screw pier testing, site compound establishment, overhead infrastructure relocation and mast foundation works completed.

Upcoming works (see map on back)

Customers and the local community can expect to see the following activities in mid-2023:

- **Site establishment works** - from Monday 17 July, sections of the carpark and parts of both platforms will be progressively fenced off as required. These areas will be used to store materials and equipment and undertake works. Both platforms will remain open with reduced widths in construction areas.
- Several **platform shelters** will be removed with some replaced by temporary shelters.
- **Bike locker relocation** - if you have a bike locker please empty it and hand your keys to station staff by 31 July. You will be notified of alternative bike storage by 21 July.

Works will generally take place 6am to 6pm Monday to Saturday, unless notified.

Impacts

Every effort will be made to carry out these works with respect for our neighbours and customers. We apologise for any inconvenience and thank you for your patience as we build a better station.

- **Traffic changes** - stop and go traffic will be located at the Rowley Road carpark entrance to enable works and site deliveries.
- Platform and carpark area closures.
- Noise and machinery.

For your safety, please use approved paths and follow directional signage and traffic control.

About the project

The Burpengary station accessibility upgrade will deliver an improved station and facilities that provide a service that is accessible, easy to get to, and easy to use.

These improvements enable all customers to access the train, station and platforms via paths, ramps or lifts, without the need to use stairs.

Key features of the upgrade include:

- a new footbridge with lift access
- improved accessible parking
- full length high-level platforms
- upgraded hearing augmentation loops and tactile ground surface indicators
- upgraded security cameras and lighting
- new wayfinding and platform signage
- new station office and facilities.
