

# SEQ Rail Stabling Program

## Woombye – Noise wall construction update

From **Tuesday 27 February 2018**, CPB Contractors and Queensland Rail will commence works to construct the noise barrier within the existing rail corridor between 2 Keil Street and 13 New Street, opposite the Woombye stabling facility.

These works will include site establishment and construction preparatory works such as setting up the site compound, tree-trimming and vegetation removal. Construction of the wall will commence shortly after and will involve installation of footings and panels. Works will be undertaken from Monday to Saturday between 6.30am and 5.30pm. This work is expected to be complete by mid-2018, construction conditions and weather permitting.

Construction works originally scheduled for January were delayed as Queensland Rail needed to undertake design modification work.



### What to expect:

- Excavator, skid steer loader and trucks for clearing of the works area
- Post hole drilling and excavation
- Installation of posts and panels
- Light vehicle traffic around the works area
- The use of hand tools.
