

SEQ Rail Stabling Program - Elimbah vegetation removal and concrete works

CPB Contractors is carrying out minor vegetation removal at the Elimbah stabling facility construction site between **Monday 24 October 2016 and Saturday 5 November 2016**, in preparation for the installation of the wastewater treatment system.

Works to pour concrete for the stabling facility's footpaths will commence from 6am each day, for a period of two weeks, to reduce heat stress in the concrete.

All vegetation removal is undertaken in accordance with required environmental guidelines. A fauna spotter will be on-site to survey the trees prior to clearing.
