

Cannon Hill station accessibility upgrade

PROJECT UPDATE – DECEMBER 2021

The Cannon Hill station accessibility upgrade is part of the State Government's ongoing investment of more than \$500 million to upgrade stations across the South East Queensland network, making them more accessible for customers.

Project progress


The following works have recently been carried out at Cannon Hill station:

- new kerb ramp to Barrack Road footpath at the northern park 'n' ride entrance
- demolition of temporary shelters, footings and slabs, and platform painting and grouting
- installation of roof sheeting to northern park 'n' ride canopy and metal fence panels along the back of both platforms (image below)
- new concrete seating constructed in the southern park 'n' ride and on platform 2
- installation of new switchboards, isolation transformer and communication racks
- permanent power connected and new permanent platform, stair and footbridge lighting installed.

Upcoming works

Customers and the local community can expect to see the following activities over the coming weeks:

- installation of footpath at the back of platform 2
- ongoing lightpole installations throughout station
- installation of downpipes to the back of platform canopies and all footbridge stairs
- installation of platform infrastructure and signage
- ongoing paving, station entrance and lift shaft works (image across)
- landscaping to garden beds and raised planter beds.

Construction impacts

During the station upgrade, changes due to construction activities may include:

- changed parking and traffic conditions for safety
- noise associated with heavy machinery
- temporary changes to access paths throughout the station precinct and surrounding areas
- increased vehicle movements near works
- the use of mobile lighting towers (for night works).

Normal working hours are 6.30am to 6.30pm, Monday to Saturday.

The local community will be given advance notice of construction activities likely to cause impacts, including after hours work (nights, Sundays and public holidays).
