

Early morning concrete works

Banyo pedestrian footbridge

Thursday 29 and Friday 30 June 2017

Queensland Rail is constructing a new pedestrian bridge at the northern end of Banyo station.

In order to construct the footings for the footbridge, concrete works will be undertaken at the work sites on platforms 1 and 2.

This work will be carried out from 5am on Thursday 29 and Friday 30 June 2017 (weather and construction conditions permitting).
