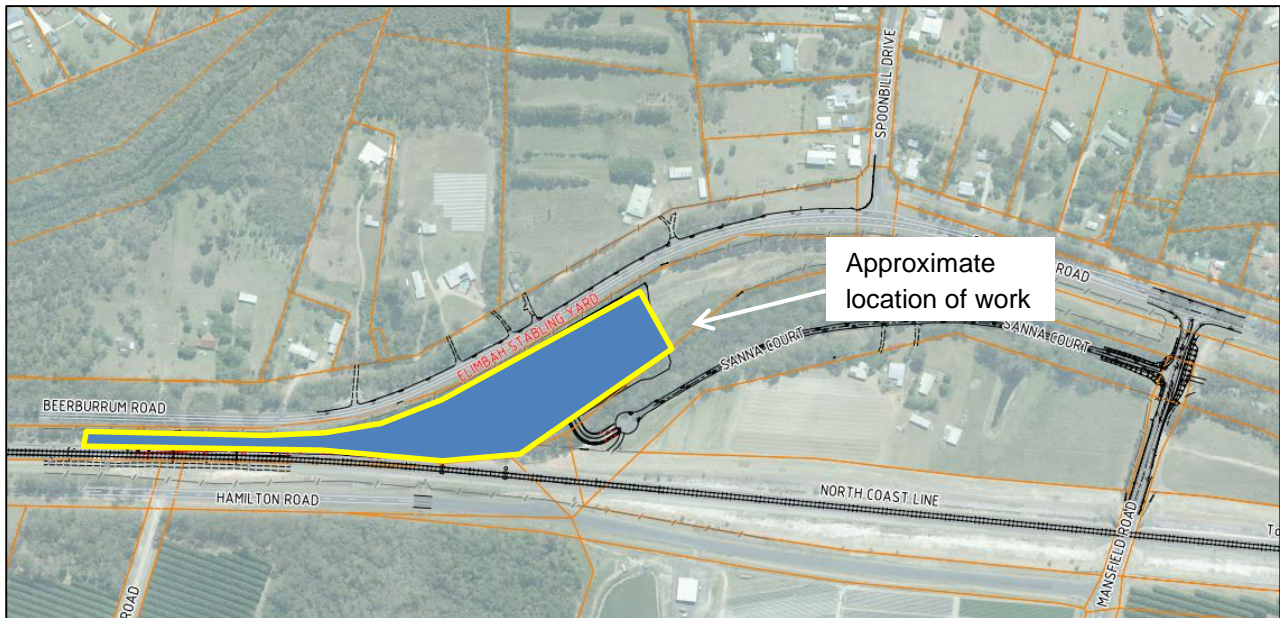


## SEQ Rail Stabling Program Elimbah construction notice



As part of the SEQ Rail Stabling Program, CPB Contractors will be undertaking construction activities between Beerburrum Road and the rail corridor during the scheduled track closure of the North Coast line on 28 and 29 January 2017.

Works undertaken as part of the scheduled track closure will occur **continuously from 4am Saturday 28 January until 10pm Sunday 29 January 2017**, weather permitting.

The scheduled track closure works will include:

- Removal of existing signals
- Installing new signals
- Installation of overhead equipment masts and electrical wiring
- Signal testing and commissioning.

Works will involve:

- Delivery trucks and workers' vehicles entering the site and unloading materials via Sanna Court and Beerburrum Road
- The use of machinery, such as mobile cranes, front-end loaders, generators, track mountable excavators and small power tools, such as drills, saws and minor vibrating equipment
- Mobile lighting towers to light the work areas.

Queensland Rail and CPB Contractors will endeavor to minimise impacts to neighboring residents and businesses, including noise and dust, during construction of the Elimbah stabling facility.
