



Frederick Street bridge replacement Project update March 2023

Thank you for your support while we built your new Frederick Street entry ramp in 2022.

Queensland Rail is proud to share the news with you that we have contracted well-known Brisbane community artist, Ash Taylor, to create a beautiful mural with local icons on the ramp.

Works will recommence in March to complete earth and structural works for the Frederick Street and Mina Parade bridge entrances. Works are expected to be completed in mid-2023, weather and construction conditions permitting.

Frederick Street will be closed intermittently when works are taking place and open on non-work days and at the end of each work day. There will be lane closures on Mina Parade, with Stop and Go traffic control in place.

Works will generally take place 6am to 6pm Monday to Saturday, unless notified.
