Easter works

Indooroopilly rail bridge Friday 18 to Monday 21 April 2025





Queensland Rail will undertake weekend and public holiday works over the Easter period as part of refurbishment and repainting works on the Indooroopilly rail bridge.

These works are necessary due to delays associated with recent significant weather events including TC Alfred.

When?

Weekend and public holiday works will be carried out **from Friday 18 to Monday 21 April, 6am to 4pm** each day (day shifts only).



Where?

Works will mainly occur on the central section of the Indooroopilly Bridge (steel rail bridge between the Walter Taylor road bridge and the Albert rail bridge).

While painting activities are not expected to create excessive noise, residents may notice the operation of equipment, including generators and compressors.

There may be an increased presence of personnel and vehicles in the work compounds (beneath the bridge) on either bank of the river.
