

# Night works

## Indooroopilly rail bridge June and July 2025



### What?

Queensland Rail will undertake safety critical bridge maintenance activities after hours to support the current refurbishment works on the Indooroopilly rail bridge. Similar works were undertaken on other parts of the bridge in 2024.



### When?

Night works will be carried out each night, weather and construction conditions permitting, **from 4pm until 5am** the next day on:

- **Saturday 28 June to Friday 4 July 2025** (over seven nights)
- *Works may continue for a further week, Saturday 5 to Friday 11 July 2025, if required.*



### Where?

Works will mainly occur on the central section of the Indooroopilly Bridge (steel rail bridge between the Walter Taylor road bridge and the Albert rail bridge).

Residents may notice noise associated with the operation of machinery, including generators and compressors, and powered tools and equipment. There may be an increase in project vehicles on surrounding roads near the work compounds on either bank of the river.
