Indooroopilly rail bridge

What?

Queensland Rail will undertake bridge painting and maintenance activities after hours as part of the current refurbishment works on the Indooroopilly rail bridge.



When?

Night works will be carried out on **Tuesday 28 and Wednesday 29 October, from 10pm until 4am** the next day (over two nights).

These works have been scheduled when there are fewer rail services operating or when freight can be diverted.



Where?

Works will mainly occur on the central section of the Indooroopilly Bridge (steel rail bridge between the Walter Taylor road bridge and the Albert rail bridge).

Residents may notice noise associated with the relocation of track-level hoarding and the operation of machinery, including generators, compressors, powered tools and equipment.

There may be an increase in project vehicles on surrounding roads near the work compounds on either bank of the river.

Trucks and on-track vehicles with flashing lights and reversing beepers

Operation of machinery and equipment (generators, compressors) and powered/hand tools



Lighting towers at night
