PROJECT UPDATE - FEBRUARY 2024

The Lindum station accessibility upgrade is part of the State Government's ongoing investment to upgrade stations to make them accessible for everyone.

About the project

Lindum station is being upgraded to make it more accessible, and easier for customers and the community to travel on our network.

This will mean people in wheelchairs, parents with prams, and those with heavy luggage or who are injured, can get easy access to our trains.

The new, modern and accessible station is expected to reopen in the second half of 2024.

Project status

On Monday 22 January, Lindum station closed to allow major station upgrade works to commence.

The following works have been carried out recently at the station:

- Geotechnical investigations
- Site establishment and installation of safety fencing
- Implementation of alternative transport
- Vegetation works tree removal and trimming
- Assessment of existing structures
- Demolition of platform shelters
- Piling works (from Sibley Road carpark).

Upcoming works

Customers and the local community can expect to see the following activities in the coming weeks:

- Ongoing preparations for North Road carpark expansion
- Ongoing piling works (from North Road carpark)
- Demolition of timber footbridge
- Platform raising works.

Works will generally take place between **6am and 6pm Monday to Saturday, unless notified.** Every effort will be made to carry out these works with respect for our neighbours and customers.

With Lindum station now closed, shuttle bus route 229 is operating between Lindum and Wynnum North stations, including a stop at Iona College.
