The upgraded station is more accessible, making it easier for customers to travel on our network.


People in wheelchairs, parents with prams and those travelling with luggage or who are injured, will be able to access our trains with ease.

Construction progress

Activities recently undertaken at Lindum include:

- opening of Sibley Road kiss 'n' ride
- progressive reopening of the Sibley Road park 'n'
- northern park 'n' ride entrance and associated roadworks (Eccles Street).





Upcoming works

Customers and the community can expect to see the following activities in the coming weeks:

- continuing northern park 'n' ride expansion works (pictured, left)
- completion of new bicycle facilities
- landscaping establishment and maintenance
- finishing touches throughout the station precinct
- demobilisation of project offices and reinstatement of final section of Sibley Road park 'n' ride.

Construction impacts

Works will generally take place between **6am and 6pm**, **Monday to Saturday**, unless notified.

Prior notification will be provided for after hours activities (nights, Sundays or public holidays).
