PROJECT UPDATE – MAY 2025

The Lindum station accessibility upgrade is part of Queensland Rail's program to make our stations accessible for everyone.

About the project

Since reopening the station late last year, the project team has continued with various finishing activities throughout the precinct.

Despite experiencing significant weather events in recent months, works are continuing on the northern carpark expansion and, as works progress, more customer parking is returning to service in the Sibley Road park 'n' ride.

The upgraded station will be more accessible, making it easier for customers to travel on our network.

People in wheelchairs, parents with prams and those travelling with luggage or who are injured, will be able to access our trains with ease.

Construction progress

Activities recently undertaken at Lindum include:

- Sibley Road kiss 'n' ride (opened 19 May)
- progressive reopening of sections of the Sibley Road park 'n' ride
- Northern park 'n' ride expansion works excavation and kerbing (ongoing)
- commencement of northern park 'n' ride entry and roadworks (Eccles Street).

Upcoming works

Customers and the community can expect to see the following activities in the coming weeks:

- continuing construction of path connecting the station with Iona College
- continuing construction of new bicycle facilities
- continuing northern park 'n' ride expansion works
- continuing northern park 'n' ride entry and roadworks (Eccles Street)
- landscaping establishment and maintenance
- finishing touches throughout the station precinct.
