# Lindum station accessibility upgrade



PROJECT UPDATE - SEPTEMBER 2024

The Lindum station accessibility upgrade is part of the Queensland Government's investment to upgrade our stations to make them accessible for everyone.

## About the project

Lindum station is being upgraded to make it more accessible, and easier for customers and the community to travel on our network.

The new, modern station will help people in wheelchairs, parents with prams and those travelling with luggage or who are injured, to access our trains with ease.

Lindum station is expected to reopen to customers in December 2024.

## **Construction progress**

The following activities have recently been completed at Lindum:

- Platform raising and extension works (ongoing)
- Installation of platform canopy structures on platform 2
- Fabrication (off-site), delivery and installation of footbridge staircase to platform 2 and northern (North Road) carpark (pictured, below)
- Commenced construction of station building.

# **Upcoming works**

Customers and the local community can expect to see the following activities in the coming weeks:

- Continuing platform works
- Footbridge and lift shaft fit-out (screens, glazing)
- Continuing construction of station building, ticket office and entrance plazas
- Ongoing North Road carpark expansion, including drainage and entry works (Eccles Street).

Thank you for your patience and cooperation as we build you a better Lindum station.

## **Construction impacts**

During construction, localised impacts may include:

- station precinct and North Road carpark closed and limited customer parking in Sibley Road carpark
- cross-corridor pedestrian access via level crossing
- local traffic management for safety
- increased vehicle movements near works
- noise associated with construction activity.

Normal working hours are **6am to 6pm, Monday to Saturday**. Prior notification will be provided for after hours activities (nights, Sundays or public holidays).

# Planning your travel

During the station closure, an accessible shuttle bus route 229 operates between Lindum and Wynnum North stations, with a stop at Iona College.
