

Lindum station accessibility upgrade



PROJECT UPDATE – AUGUST 2024

The Lindum station accessibility upgrade is part of the State Government's ongoing investment to upgrade stations to make them accessible for everyone.

About the project

Lindum station is being upgraded to make it more accessible, and easier for customers and the community to travel on our network.

The new, modern station will help people in wheelchairs, parents with prams and those travelling with luggage or who are injured, to access our trains with ease.

Lindum station is expected to reopen to customers in the second half of 2024.

Construction progress

The following activities have been completed at Lindum station:

- Piling (foundation works) - platforms, footbridges and lift shafts
- Platform raising and extension works
- Installation of new footbridge (crane lift)
- Customer and community engagement (Wynnum North station, shuttle buses and Wynnum Plaza).

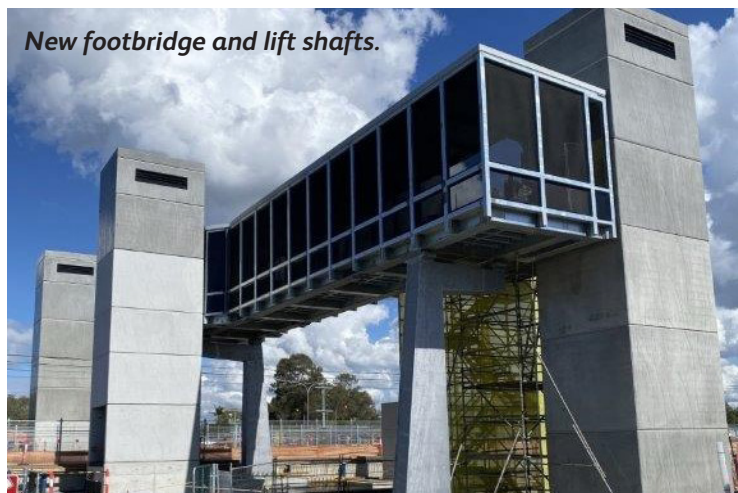
Upcoming works

Customers and the local community can expect to see the following activities in the coming weeks:

- Continuing platform works and coping stone installation
- Installation of platform canopy structures and staircases (by crane, late August)
- Footbridge and lift shaft fit out - screens and glazing
- Commence construction of station entrances and ticket office
- Ongoing North Road carpark expansion, including drainage and entry works (Eccles Street).

Construction impacts

During construction, localised impacts may include:

- station precinct and North Road carpark closed and limited customer parking in Sibley Road carpark
- cross-corridor pedestrian access via level crossing
- local traffic management for safety
- increased vehicle movements near works
- noise associated with construction activity.

Normal working hours are **6am to 6pm, Monday to Saturday**. Prior notification will be provided for after hours activities (nights, Sundays or public holidays).

Planning your travel

With the station closed, an accessible shuttle bus route 229 operates between Lindum and Wynnum North stations, with a stop at Iona College.
