

Road resurfacing

Eccles Street

Wednesday 23 to Friday 25 July 2025



What?

Following the completion of Lindum station's northern carpark expansion works, Queensland Rail's contractor will undertake resurfacing of Eccles Street.

Resurfacing works will involve the full extent of Eccles Street - removing the existing asphalt layer, sealing the gravel and then laying new asphalt to the road.

Works will be undertaken using a method and sealer which will enable driving immediately after spreading, under traffic control.



When?

Wednesday 23 until Friday 25 July (over three days, working hours each day 6:30am to 6pm).



Where?

Eccles Street. Traffic management in operation - no on-street parking available during works.

Private property (vehicle) access will generally be available, with short delays, under the direction of traffic controllers.

At times (up to approximately one hour), whenever hot bitumen is being applied, driving on the surface cannot be facilitated.
