Merivale Bridge maintenance works

Overview of planned works

Queensland Rail is undertaking essential maintenance works on the Merivale Bridge over the Brisbane River.

In addition to regular works (6.30am to 6.30pm, Monday to Saturday), continuous works will be undertaken during a scheduled track closure from **2am Saturday 5 to 3am Monday 7 November 2016**.

Brisbane River operators and users are advised to expect changed conditions during these works and should take care and follow signs around the barges.

During the continuous works, activities including beam lifting and barge movement will be undertaken in the Brisbane River. Signs will be posted on the barges to indicate no wash from vessels in the area during certain periods. All water vessel operators and river users should be aware of this operation to ensure the safety of their vessels and barge activities.

The bike and pedestrian paths along the Southbank Boardwalk will remain open for public use during these works.

Nearby residents and businesses may experience increased noise, lighting and construction activity in the area. Access to local properties will be maintained at all times.

Queensland Rail is aware that such activities may cause temporary inconvenience to our valued neighbours. While every effort will be made to carry out these works with minimal disruption, Queensland Rail apologises for any inconvenience and thanks the local community for their cooperation during these important works.
