Morningside station accessibility upgrade



PROJECT UPDATE – MAY 2025

The Morningside station accessibility upgrade is part of Queensland Rail's program to make our stations accessible for everyone.

Since the station reopened in late 2024, further progress has been made towards finalising the station upgrade.

Recent works completed include:

- completion of station landscaping
- installation of the winning station accessibility upgrade photography competition artwork
- completion of lighting and security upgrades in the southern carpark
- further removal of contractor site office from the northern end of the park 'n' ride
- asphalting and line marking of carpark in the northern end of the park 'n' ride.

Ongoing works

Some of the remaining upgrade activities include:

- resurfacing the park 'n' ride driveway access
- installation of bird guards on steel piers above platforms 1 and 2
- completion and fitout of the bicycle storage facility
- completion and reopening of additional parking spaces in the northern end of the park 'n' ride.

Construction impacts

Works will generally take place between 6am and 6pm Monday to Saturday, unless notified.

Every effort will be made to carry out these works with respect for our neighbours and customers.

Weekend works will occur on Saturday 24 and Sunday 25 May, and Saturday 7 and Sunday 8 June 2025 during planned closures of the inner city and Cleveland lines.

Patricia's winning photograph, titled 'Bright Night', beautifully captures the infamous 'eyesore' - the iconic footbridge that once connected Wynnum Road to the station platforms.

Patricia's photograph, taken on day 327 a of year long photo a day challenge, was taken in 2012. Now, 13 years later the photo provides a brightly illuminated memory of the bridge which has made way for a more inclusive access to Morningside station.

The footbridge, a feature of the station since 1992, had its last section removed in February 2025 as part of the station accessibility upgrade.
