## Overnight stabling of test train

As part of the testing and training for the Woombye stabling facility, a test train from Queensland Rail's existing fleet will be located at the facility on Tuesday 27 and Wednesday 28 February.

The testing activities will involve the train being stabled overnight in the facility, and lighting turned on for security purposes.

The Woombye stabling facility is anticipated to be fully operational later this year, when trains will be stored overnight and cleaned on a daily basis. As the facility has now been completed and commissioned, you may notice that on occasion trains may use the facility for testing and training purposes. The community will be advised in advance of the facility becoming fully operational.
