

East Ipswich station accessibility upgrade



PROJECT UPDATE – NOVEMBER 2021

The East Ipswich station accessibility upgrade is part of the State Government's ongoing investment of more than \$500 million to upgrade stations across the South East Queensland network, making them accessible for all customers.

Project progress

The following works were recently undertaken at East Ipswich:

- removal of old timber footbridge
- opening of new footbridge (stair-only)
- platform works (ongoing)
- station building works
- ongoing lift installation
- commissioning of the new lighting system
- entrance ramp works – Coronation Street
- station entrance works (ongoing).

Upcoming works

In the coming weeks, customers and the community can expect to see the following activities:

- ongoing lift installation
- ongoing station building and platform works
- ticket office fit-out
- installation of new bike facilities
- station entrance and footpath works.

Demolition of the old station building and platforms, will continue into 2022.



Construction impacts

During works, construction activities may involve:

- changed parking and traffic conditions for safety
- noise associated with heavy machinery
- temporary changes to access paths throughout the station precinct and surrounding areas
- increased vehicle movements near works
- mobile lighting towers for night works.

Normal working hours are 6.30am to 6.30pm, Monday to Saturday.

The local community will be given advance notification of construction activities likely to cause impacts, including after hours work (nights, Sundays and public holidays, if required).
