The Banyo station accessibility upgrade is part of the State Government's ongoing investment to upgrade stations to make them accessible for everyone.

Project benefits

Banyo station is being upgraded to make it more accessible, and easier for customers and the community to travel on our network. The new, modern station will help people in wheelchairs, parents with prams and those travelling with luggage or who are injured use the station with ease.



Construction progress


Since the closure of Banyo station on Monday 22 January 2024, major work has been progressing on site including:

- 🗸 site establishment
- demolition of platform structures, waiting shelters and station building
- \checkmark dismantling of platform shelter shed
- removal of existing footbridge staircase (for modification)
- \checkmark electrical and optic fibre works
- ✓ foundation works for platform raising
- ✓ piling works for new footbridge and lifts
- excavation and concrete removal of original station entrance ramps
- ✓ overhead line works.

You can expect to see the following upcoming activities on site:

- ongoing piling works for new structures
- construction of new raised platforms
- ongoing station entrance excavation
- construction of new St Vincent's Road entrance plaza
- installation of lift shafts.

Works will generally take place between 6am and 6pm Monday to Saturday, unless notified. Every effort will be made to carry out these works with respect for our neighbours and customers.

Alternative transport

Shuttle bus 316 continues to operate between Banyo and Northgate stations to keep customers moving during the station upgrade.
